RELIGION

Lent will be an important topic of discussion as we prepare for Easter.

READING/LANGUAGE ARTS

We will start reading the fifth book of our reading series. It is very important that your child learns to **read** the high frequency words each week and apply the new phonics skill learned. Keep reading at home and filling out Reading Records!

We are working on:

- Phonics long o (CV, CVCe), long u (CVCe), long e (CVCe, ee, ea), final sounds: ng, nk, phonograms: -ean, -ink, ay, -ain, -ow, -oat, vowels: ai, ay, oa, ow, contractions: 'll, 'd, 've, 're
- Vocabulary suffixes -y and -ful, classification of transportation words, multiple-meaning words, synonyms
- Comprehension Skills main idea and details, compare and contrast, author's purpose, drawing conclusions
- Comprehension Strategies asking questions and visualizing about what you are reading, summarizing, and finding ways to figure out what doesn't make sense
- Writing write to narrate using sentences, writing a friendly letter, writing a personal narrative We will be working on:
- Phonics r-controlled vowels (ar, or, ore, er, ir, ur), phonograms -ar, -ore
- Vocabulary prefix re- and using a dictionary entry
- Comprehension Skills identifying story structure (setting, character, and events) and drawing conclusions
- Comprehension Strategies analyzing and evaluating text, visualization
- Writing writing to express sentences with dialogue and verbs

MATH

Skills to be covered this month include:

- place value concepts & money
- tens & teens
- place value to 100
- addition strategies
- understanding money
- counting collections of objects by tens

SOCIAL STUDIES

We will begin a unit titled Everything Changes. The focus of our lessons will be: learning about the past, the First Americans, family life past and present, and going to school long ago.
