RELIGION

We will begin Unit 3 in our book, Jesus Christ. We will be learning about Jesus the healer, Jesus teaches love, and Jesus teaches us to pray. We will also give thanks to God for all of our blessings as we celebrate Thanksgiving.

READING/LANGUAGE ARTS

We are completing our first reading book and will start the second! Make sure you are practicing the phonics skills and vocabulary words we have learned so far at home.

We are working on:

- Phonics reviewing short a, double final consonants and ck, phonogram -ack
- Vocabulary classifying and categorizing action words
- Comprehension Skills understanding characters
- Comprehension Strategies summarizing
- Writing writing to describe (adjectives)

We will be working on:

- Phonics reviewing short I, o, and e; clusters with r, l, and s; phonograms ip, and ock,
- Vocabulary using a glossary, classifying and categorizing time words, antonyms
- Comprehension Skills giving details about a text, sequence of events, text and graphic features
- Comprehension Strategies inferring/predicting, analyzing texts, and questioning
- Writing writing to describe poetry and a thank- you note

MATH

We will learn:

- The strategy counting on
- Writing a number sentence
- Adding doubles
- Using fact cards to practice facts

We will be introducing:

- Counting on from the greater number
- Mixed practice with equations
- Problem solving

SOCIAL STUDIES

We will start our unit on Where We Live. We will learn about the earth, land, water, natural resources, weather and seasons, cities, towns, suburbs, and our country.

SCIENCE

We will continue our unit on Solids and Liquids.
